<p>4.1 Academic Contribution</p>	<p>Submissions must present original, unpublished research that demonstrates clear motivation, advances existing knowledge and has potential applicability for policymaking and practice.</p>
<p>4.2 Conformity to Journal Scope</p>	<p>All submitted manuscripts undergo a preliminary editorial check to ensure alignment with the journal’s aims and scope before being sent for peer review.</p>
<p>5. Journal Standards</p>	
<p>5.1 Bibliographic Data & Literature Citation</p>	<p>The journal strictly follows the APA (7th Edition) citation and referencing style.</p>
<p>5.2 Font & Design</p>	<p>The journal uses a professional and clean layout (Times New Roman, 12-point font, double-spaced) to ensure maximum readability in both print and online formats.</p>
<p>5.3 Infographics & Exhibits</p>	<p>High-resolution (300 DPI or higher) images, tables and graphs are required. All visuals must be clearly labelled and cited appropriately.</p>
<p>5.4 Citation Record</p>	<p>To be established as the journal is progressively indexed in academic databases.</p>
<p>5.5 Print Continuum</p>	<p>The journal maintains a consistent quarterly publication schedule for both print and online editions.</p>
<p>5.6 Quality of Website</p>	<p>The website is professionally managed, regularly updated with new issues and announcements and features a user-friendly interface for easy navigation.</p>
<p>5.7 Multilingual Availability</p>	<p>While the primary language of publication is English, the journal encourages authors to provide abstracts in Gujarati and/or Hindi to enhance reach within the Indian context.</p>

<p>6.1 Ethical Guidelines for Authors</p>	<p>Clear ethical guidelines based on COPE (Committee on Publication Ethics) are provided to authors, covering authorship, data integrity and originality.</p>

<p>6.2 Plagiarism Prevention</p>	<p>All submissions are mandatorily checked for plagiarism using latest software. A similarity index below the prescribed limit (typically 10%) is expected. For AI generated content, the limit is as prescribed by UGC.</p>
<p>6.3 Conflict of Interest Disclosure</p>	<p>All authors, reviewers and editors are required to disclose any potential conflicts of interest that could influence the research or its interpretation.</p>
<p>6.4 AI Generated Content Policy</p>	<p>The journal has a specific policy regarding the use of AI tools in research and writing. The use of generative AI to create content is not permitted, but AI tools for editing and improving language are permissible with full disclosure.</p>
<p>7. Journal Visibility 7.1 Impact Factor or Similar Factor</p>	<p>Not yet applicable. The journal is working towards meeting the criteria for evaluation by recognised rating agencies.</p>
